We have built up experience in reaching these people, getting to know them, having effective gospel conversations with them – and by God's grace we have seen thousands of men, women and children commit their lives to follow Jesus.

We love coming alongside people like you to reach these people together – sharing our resources and experience – and we love seeing churches growing and thriving as a result.

- You'll be supported spiritually throughout the course, and will be assigned a mentor who will encourage you and pray with you.

- You're a Christian, living for Jesus.
- You're passionate about sharing the message of Jesus with people around you.
- You come from a background where the gospel isn't widely known.
- You've been part of your current church for at least a year, and have their recommendation and support.
- You have some experience of evangelistic ministry, however small.
- You're over 18 years old but currently unable to access training otherwise.
- You're willing to commit to a two-year programme of study, including maintaining journals, and attending lectures.
- You're self-motivated and able to manage your own workload.
- You're ready for an adventure!



# THEOLOGICAL TRAINING, Mentoring & Small Groups

We provide engaging, weekly lectures in a relaxed and interactive classroom setting to help deepen your understanding of the gospel and how it applies to people in London. Modules include Bible overview, practical evangelism training, pastoral care, apologetics and much more. There is some basic written coursework to complete throughout the course.

We also want to make sure you're thriving and supported so, once a month, you'll meet with your mentor who will walk by your side and pray for you throughout the course, and with whom you can share your questions and experiences. You'll also be part of a small group of other trainees who meet regularly to talk, share and pray about personal needs and the joys and challenges of ministry.

The lectures and mentoring take place through LCM's Foundation Course. This course is open to others as well, such as LCM staff members and individuals who are seeking to learn more about theology and evangelism.

# PLACEMENT

Jesus sent his disciples out to serve two-by-two while he taught them: on-the-job training. We know how important it is to practice hands-on what you've learnt in lectures so one day a week, you'll spend valuable time with an experienced LCM field worker or with a partner organisation who'll train you in their ministry context.

# HOME CHURCH MINISTRY

You're a pioneer for a reason. You'll be responsible for initiating an outreach ministry in your home church or helping to develop an existing one. The Biblical literacy and practical training should culminate in urban gospel work relevant to your local area which supports your church in reaching out to the lost and will leave a legacy after the two-year programme is over.

# WHO WILL BE TRAINING YOU?

We've got a great team of godly, wise and experienced with years of training in evangelism and discipleship and breaking down the Bible in engaging and relevant ways. Their experience in counselling and pastoral care will help you to care for people well. They'll equip you with a toolkit for studying the Bible, understanding doctrine and practically applying that learning into evangelism and apologetics.

Born in east London to Christian parents, Phil became a Christian in his teens. He studied at London Bible College and served as a church evangelist in south-west London before joining LCM in 1989. He organises LCM's mentoring programme and provides pastoral support for new LCM staff. He also trains local churches in reaching their communities.

# WHAT'S YOUR CHURCH'S ROLE?

Integral to the success of the programme and our training is the support of your church leadership.

Although we will meet separately with them to discuss the details, here are the basics of their involvement:

- See evangelistic outreach as a priority.
- Familiarise themselves with the programme and take an active role in overseeing you.
- Be open to new ideas and ready to let you try a new evangelistic ministry.
- Make sure you're cared for in this demanding new phase of your Christian life.
- Encourage others in the church to support you, both practically and spiritually.
- Prayerfully consider contributing to the financial costs of the Pioneer in a spirit of generosity and out of love for the lost in London.

### **HOW MUCH DOES IT COST?**

Thanks to God's provision through the generous donations of our supporters, the programme is free and you'll receive a part-time salary (24 hours per week).

You'll also be entitled to statutory sick pay and annual leave.

There remains a significant cost to LCM to train and mentor each Pioneer and give them a salary, even with the donations from supporters, so we invite the Pioneer's church to give a reasonable annual gift according to the size of their church income as a shared financial commitment to reaching the people in London who are unlikely to hear the gospel.





# WHATS NEXT?

If you feel that the Pioneer programme might be a good fit for you, here's what needs to happen.

### WHAT YOU NEED TO DO:

- 1. Thoroughly and prayerfully read through the job description and application form at **Icm.org.uk/pioneers.**
- 2. Talk through it with the church leader who would be responsible for overseeing your church day each week.
- Complete the application form and return it to personnel@lcm.org.uk before the closing date on our website.

### WHAT YOUR CHURCH LEADER NEEDS TO DO:

- 1. Get familiar with the programme, your job role and the support they'll need to give.
- 2. Complete the recommendation form and return it to **personnel@lcm.org.uk** before the closing date on our website.
- 3. Be ready to meet with us to discuss the programme and your suitability for it.

### WHAT WE'LL DO:

- 1. Once we have your application we'll be in touch within a few weeks of the closing date to invite you to an interview or to let you know your application wasn't successful.
- 2. If we do take your application further, we'll meet with your church leader to make sure they're fully on board to support and oversee you.
- 3. We'll then be in touch by the beginning of July, with either an offer to join or to thank you for your application.
- Once you're accepted on the programme, you'll need a DBS check before you can start. We'll let you know what paperwork and information you'll then need to provide about your church's ministry.
