General Summary of Position

The volunteer Schools Worker would

- Plan, prepare and deliver high-quality RE lessons on the Christian Faith in line with the Southwark Agreed Syllabus. Syllabus units/ lesson series include 'Why do Christians celebrate Christmas?' What does it mean to belong to Christianity? Why is the Bible special to Christians?

- Liaise with School staff including teachers and Heads of Department to organise and facilitate a lesson timetable which best serves the needs of the school and can be accommodated by the Schools Worker
- Teach not preach the Christian faith to children from a variety of religious and non-religious backgrounds.
- Be supported by other members of the London City Mission Schools Work team in their ministry to the school.
- Represent the ethos and reputation of London Schools Work Ministry faithfully.

Tasks

- Plan and prepare lessons which creatively and faithfully teach the Christian faith with accuracy and clarity.
- Deliver lessons
- Liaise with staff members regarding timetables and the needs of the school
- Undergo London City Mission Schools Work induction and further training where necessary
- Teach not preach the Christian Faith with the intention of informing and enhancing pupils' knowledge and reflection on the Christian faith not with the intention of conversion.
- Respond to the questions of children (and staff) with truth, grace and sensitivity and be willing to further research the question if needs be.

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
